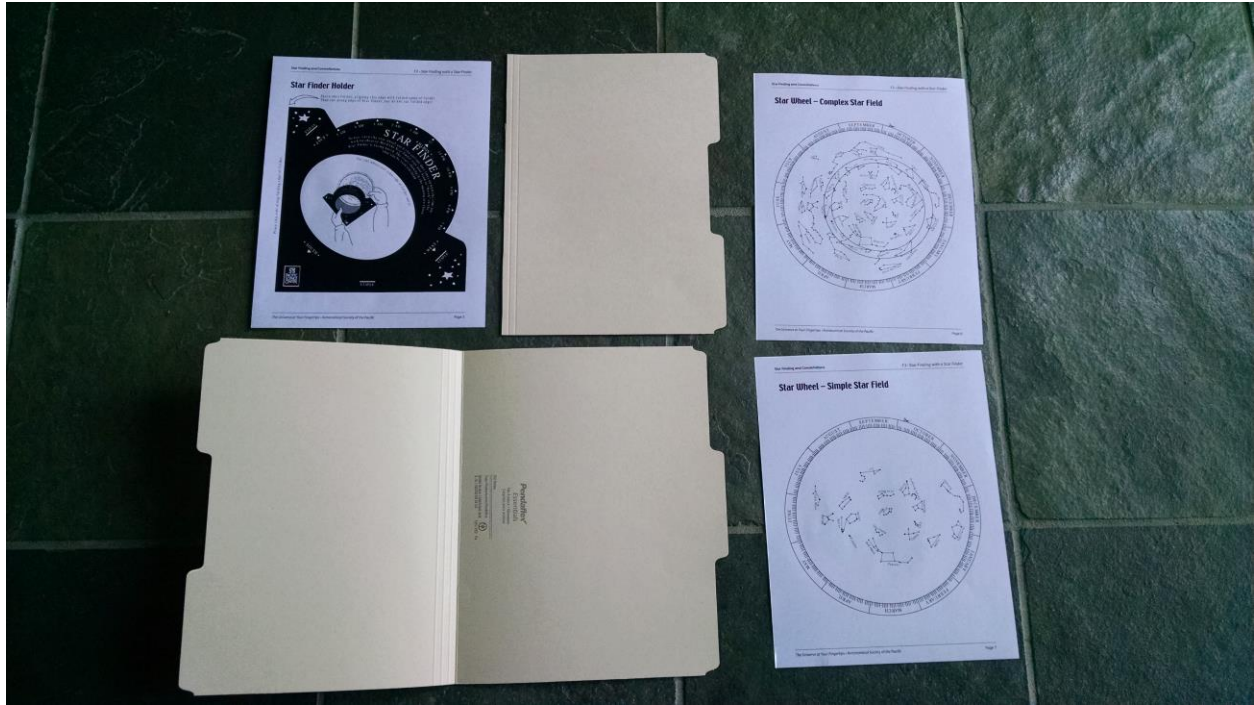
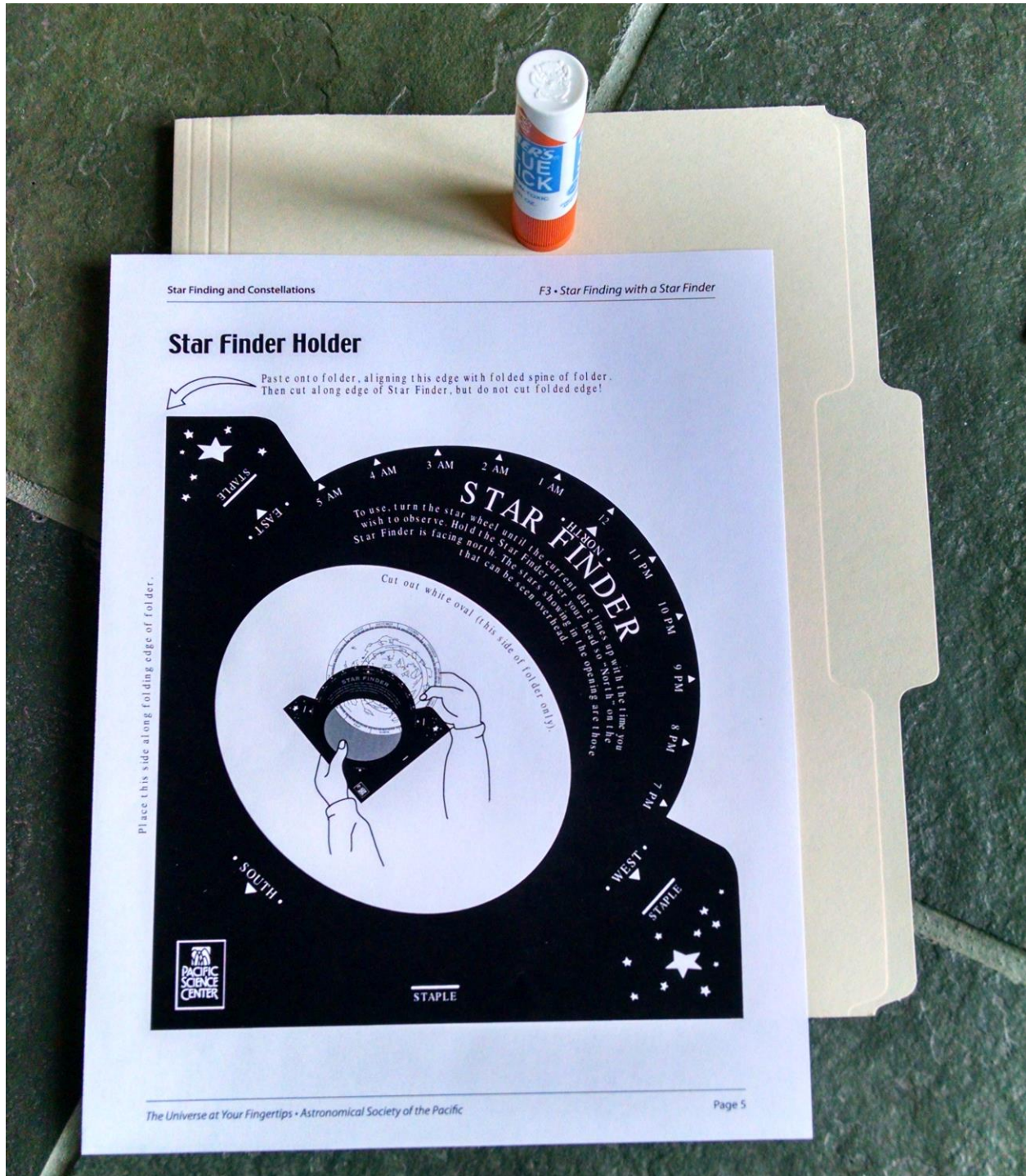


How to Assemble Your TVS Planisphere

What you should have – A manila folder, half of a manila folder, Star Finder Holder page, Star Wheel Simple page, Star Wheel Complex page. You will also need some glue, (a glue stick works well), scissors, and a stapler.



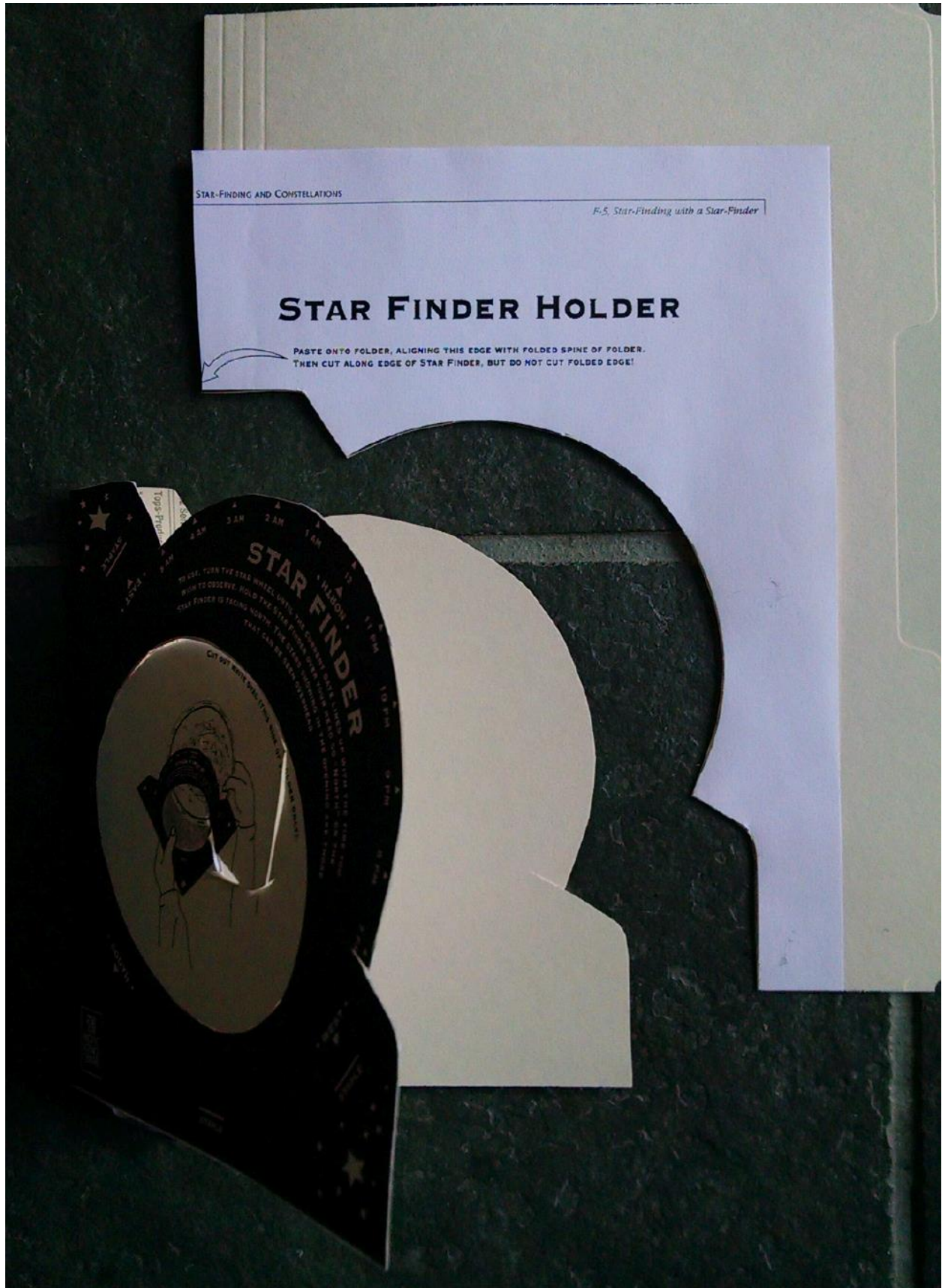
Glue the Star Finder holder page to the front of the manila folder, aligning the left edge of the black image with the fold, and the bottom of the image with the bottom of the folder.



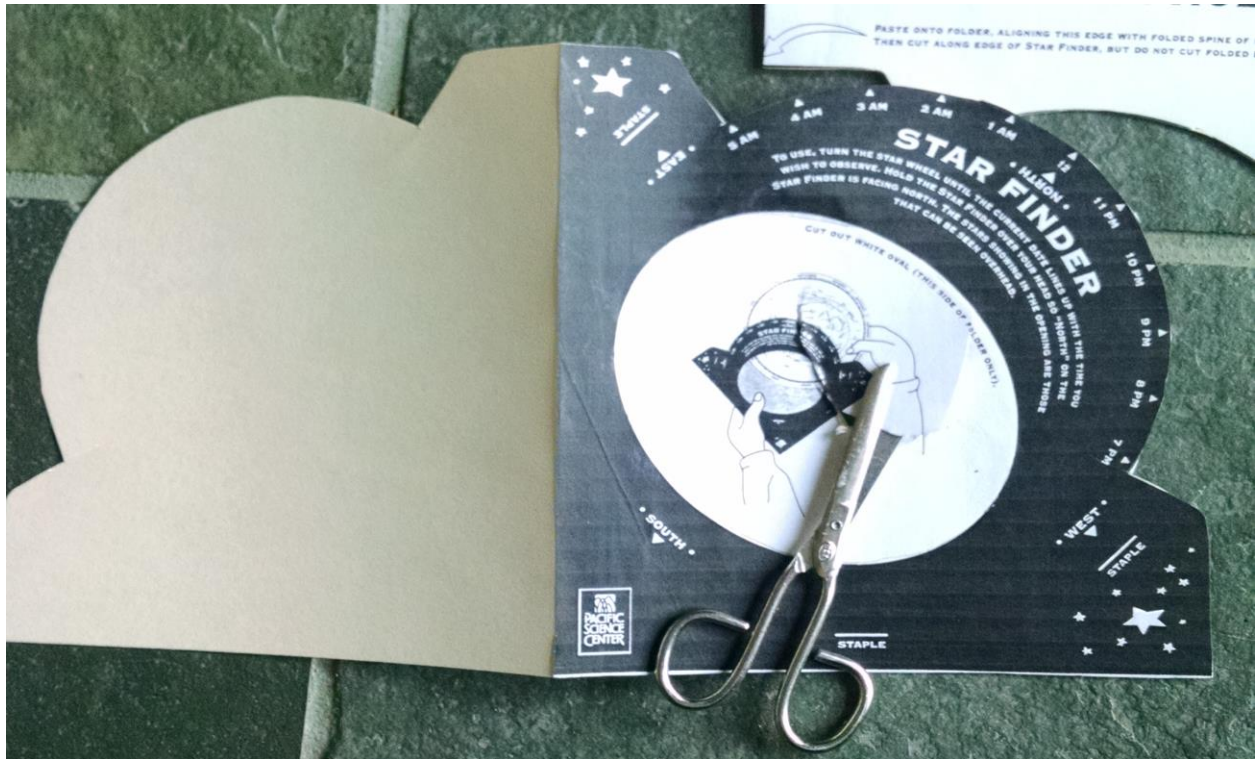
Cut out the black Star Finder along with both parts of the manila folder. Don't cut off the hinge of the manila folder.



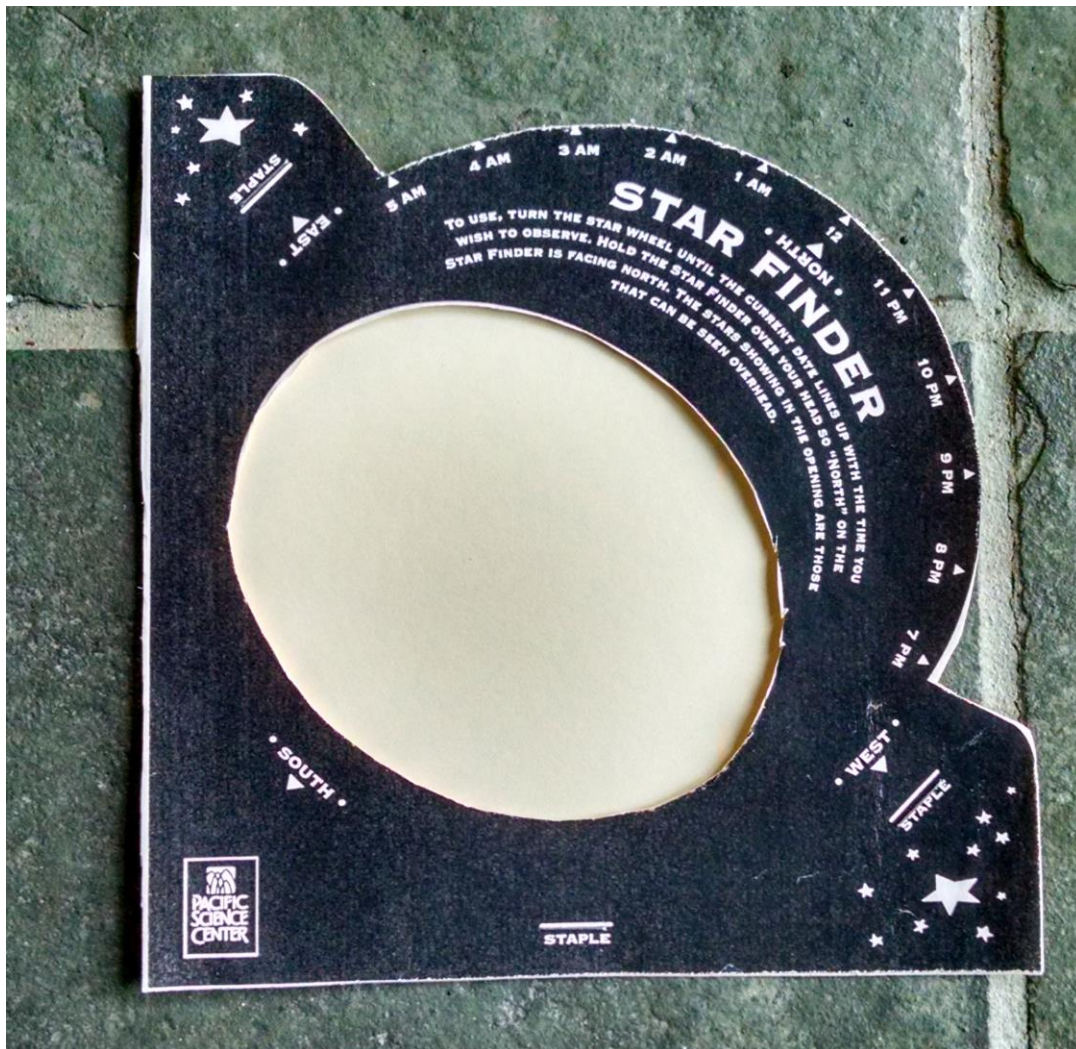
You should now have this:



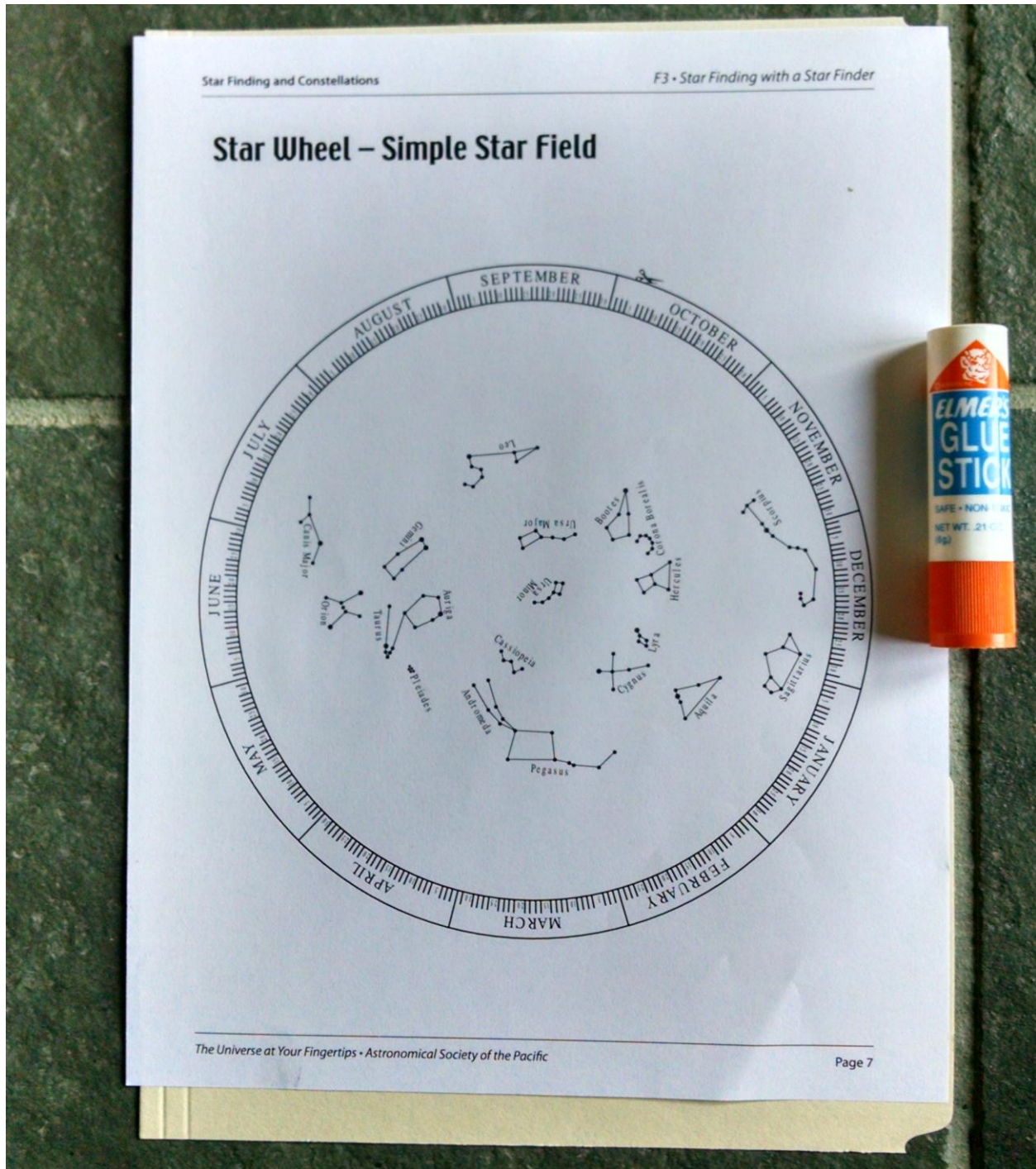
Now cut out the center section, THE TOP PAGE ONLY!



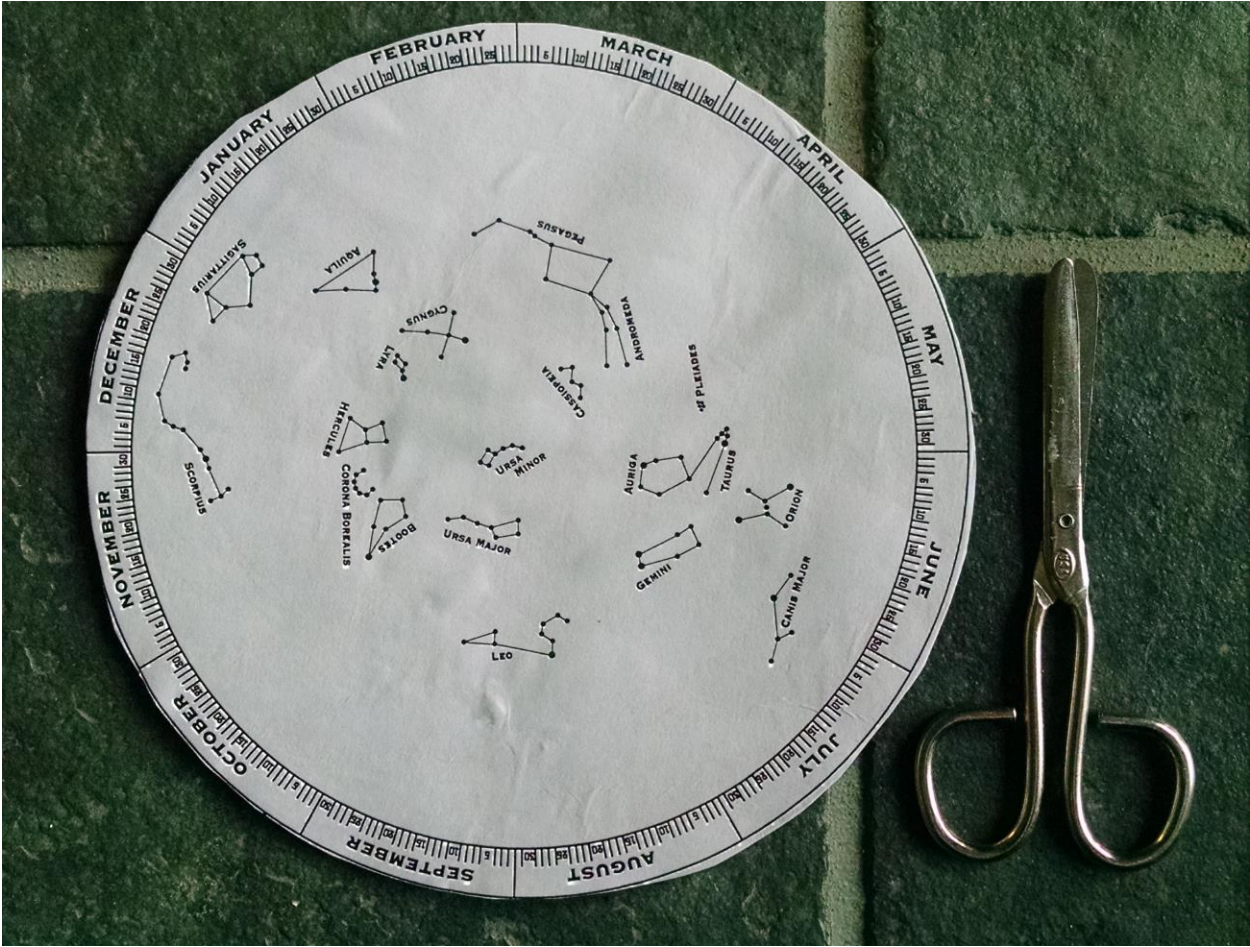
So it looks like this.



Next glue the simple Star Field onto the single sheet of manila folder.



Then cut it out like this.



Cut out the Complex Star Field, and then glue it to the other side of the Simple Star Field pattern. Don't try to line up the months, they don't line up!



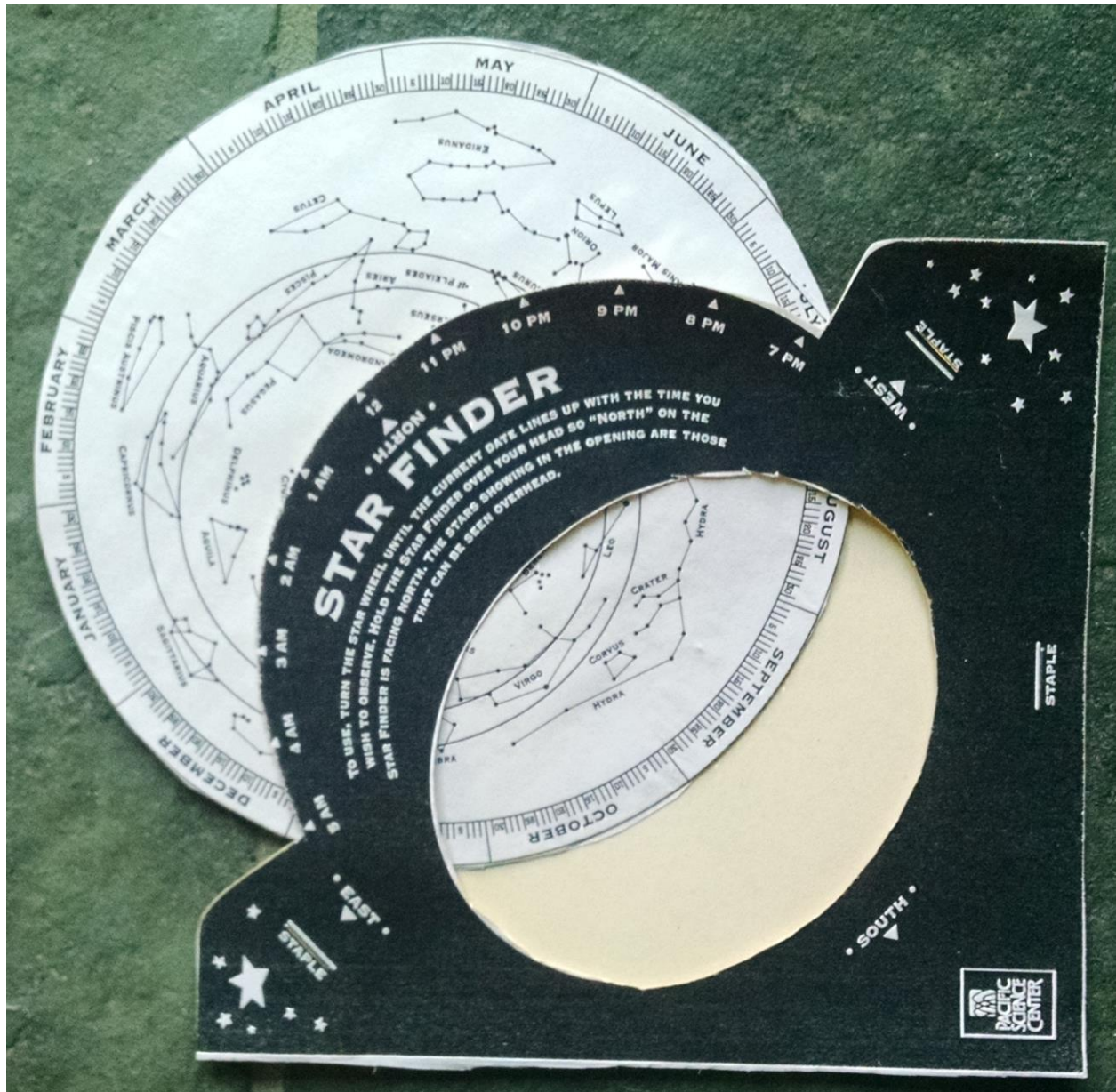
You now have something like this.



Staple in three places, as marked on the page.



Insert the star wheel into the Star Finder Housing.



And you are done!

Set the day of the month opposite the current time, and you now have a basic map of the constellations in the sky!
